

Subject: IMPORTANT: Preparation for our anticipated separation into two new companies in January of 2022.



Dear Valued Supplier,

Tate & Lyle [announced an agreement](#) in July to separate our food & beverage solutions business (remains with Tate & Lyle) and primary products business (becomes the new company Primient). The separation will create two stronger businesses, requiring new accounts for new legal entities.

New account information required after the separation

Here is a summary of some of the new account information that will be required on February 1, 2022, if the separation completes towards the end of January as anticipated:

We will provide all required information including legal entities names approximately 60 days prior to February 1st. Please contact us now if you will need more time.

Who will assist us with the change?

Your current Tate & Lyle Global Category Manager / Procurement Contact will reach out to you to help you update the customer information on existing contracts and agreements. If you have concerns about meeting the anticipated February 1 timeline, please feel free to contact them.

Will my contact(s) change?

In some cases, your contacts will change with the separation. We will advise you of any changes to your Global Category Manager / Procurement contacts in a future email.

Is it business as usual until the separation targeted for end of January 2022?

Yes, until then please continue to conduct transactions, ship products, and provide services as you are today. DO NOT use the new accounts before separation. We will have more information once details are available in approximately 30 days.

What happens to existing Purchase Orders on February 1?

We will provide instructions closer to the February 1 date.

How will you keep me informed?
